Sent to Alton, IL and transferred to Fort Delaware on 2/29/1864. Released on oath on 6/11/1865. [Color-bearer at Gettysburg on 7/1/1863. Was captured, along with the regiment's colors at the Railroad Cut by Corporal Frank Wallar of the 6th Wisconsin Infantry Regiment (for which Wallar was awarded a Congressional Medal of Honor)].

Hospital records do show him admitted on 7/16/1863 with a wound to the right thigh). Returned to duty. Appointed 4th Corporal on 5/1/1864. Mortally wounded (in abdomen) in battle at the Weldon Railroad on 8/19/1864. Died on 8/21/1864 of wounds (on ROH 5 times).

On list of prisoners who object to being exchanged. Note says he wishes to be released on oath and bond. Escaped from Alton on 9/24/1864.
