B	Braddock	Stephen	B.	21	Killed at battle of Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863.
B	Norton	Jacob	A.	21	Wounded at Gaines Mill on 6/27/1862. Returned to duty. Wounded in battle at Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863. Sent to hospital. Returned to duty. Wounded at The Wilderness on 5/6/1864. Sent to hospital. Returned to duty on 8/1/1864. Wounded at the Weldon Railroad on 8/18/1864 (or 8/19/1864 -- two conflicting records). Furloughed 40-days from 8/30/1864. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, VA on 4/9/1865.
D	Hicks	John	J.	30	Elected 2nd Lieutenant. on 4/23/1862. Accompanying list of engagements show him wounded on 9/17/1862 at Sharpsburg (muster records do not so indicate). Promoted to Captain on 7/3/1863. Again, engagements list indicates he was wounded on 10/14/1863 at Bristoe Station (Company muster rolls do not so indicate). Severely wounded at The Wilderness on 5/5/1864. Sent to hospital in Richmond. Furloughed 60-days. Retired for disability due to wounds on 1/10/1865.
E	Monk	George	W.	28	Listed as 4th Sergeant during May, 1861. Discharged on 8/21/1861 for disability by order of General Johnston. Re-enlisted on 2/22/1862 for 3-years or the war as a Private at Guntown, MS by Capt. Bates. Killed in action at Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863.

F	Herring	Robert	A.	21	Wounded at Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863. In hospital at Richmond. Furloughed for 30-days from 2/25/1864. Never returned. Deserted.
F	Pennybaker	Samuel	L.	19	Wounded (left thigh) at Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863. Sent to hospital at Richmond. Returned to duty. Wounded in battle at Deep Bottom on 6/25/1864. Sent to hospital. Furloughed 60-days from 7/21/1864. Listed as AWOL from 11/20/1864. Surrendered to Federal forces in Mississippi on 4/9/1865. Paroled at Holly Springs on 6/9/1865.
H,I	Whitesides	Moses	H.	18	Transferred to Company I from Company H on 5/1/1863 by order of Colonel Stone. Hospital records show he was admitted for a wound (gunshot wound, left hip) at Richmond, VA on 7/21/1863 (date of wound or engagement not given in company records). Returned to duty on 8/24/1863. Mortally wounded (head) at Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863. Died of wounds on 11/6/1863 at Richmond, VA (other records show death on 11/5/1863). .
K	Holt	Isaac	J.	36	Wounded at battle of Bristoe Station on 10/14/1863. Furloughed home for 60-days from 1/5/1864. Listed as AWOL from end of furlough. Dropped from rolls during Nov/Dec, 1864 muster for prolonged AWOL. Deserted.
