

Malvern Hill Casualties - 2nd Mississippi Infantry Regiment

A	Beaty	J.	L.	19	Wounded at Malvern Hill (according to company muster records). However, he appears on a Confederate list of casualties wounded on 6/27/1862. This would mean he was wounded at Gaines Mill, not Malvern Hill. Furloughed. Returned to duty. Wounded at Gettysburg (date not given). Subsequently died from wounds on Nov. 25, 1863.
A	Booth	Joel	W.	18	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Never returned from furlough. Listed as deserter from 10/1/1862.
A	Nash	Richard		19	Wounded in battle at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862 according to company records (however, he appears on a list of casualties dated 6/27/1862 which would place his wounding at Gaines Mill). Furloughed. Did not return. Listed as deserter during Mar/Apr, 1863 muster roll.
A	Reece	Charles	A.	18	Also see 26th Mississippi Infantry Regiment. Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862 according to company muster records (however, other records show him on a list of those wounded on 6/27/1862 at Gaines Mill). Furloughed. "Returned to the 26th Mississippi to which he originally belonged."

B,F	Powers	Henry	H.	29	Transferred to Company F on 11/18/1861 by order of Col. Falkner. Elected 2nd Lieutenant on 11/18/1861. Elected Captain on 12/3/1861. Re-elected Captain on 4/11/1862. Slightly wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Returned to duty. Wounded at Gettysburg on 7/3/1863. Captured at Gettysburg on 7/5/1863. Sent to Johnson's Island, OH. Paroled and forwarded to Point Lookout, MD for exchange on 3/14/1865. Surrendered and paroled dated Columbus, MS on 5/9/1865 (signed as Capt. Co. L 2nd Miss Regt).
C	Beachum	H.	L.	22	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Sent to hospital at Richmond, VA. Returned to duty. Wounded at Gettysburg (right leg) on 7/1/1863. Sent to hospital at Williamsburg, VA (admitted on 7/27/1863). Listed as deserter from 8/2/1863.
C	Roberts	Ruffin	A.	22	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862 (severe contusion, left thigh). Returned to duty on 8/29/1862. Listed as 1st Corporal during Nov/Dec, 1862 muster roll. Listed as 4th Sergeant during May/Jun, 1863 muster. Killed in battle at Gettysburg on 7/1/1863.
D,F	Springer	Allen		20	Transferred to Company F on 4/30/1862. Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Furloughed 30-days from 7/4/1862. Returned to duty. Deserted from Goldsborough, NC on 2/22/1863.

F	Liddell	Samuel	B.	20	Appointed 2nd Sergeant on 4/24/1862. Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Furloughed 30-days from 7/29/1862. Returned to duty. Mortally wounded and captured at Gettysburg on 7/1/1863. Some records say he died in Federal hospital the same day, others on 7/4/1863. Confederate records list him as killed in battle on 7/1/1863.
F	Luna	James	W.	30	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Killed in battle at Gettysburg on 7/1/1863 (according to Federal records, was wounded and captured and died in Federal hospital (date not given).
G	Cooper	Thomas	J. S.	18	Promoted 1st Corporal on 3/1/1862. Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Wounded (fractured rib) at battle of The Wilderness on 5/5/1864. Furloughed 60-days from 5/20/1864. Returned to duty 9/27/1864. Captured at Petersburg (Hatcher's Run?) on 4/2/1865. Taken to Fort Delaware. Released on oath on 6/11/1865.
I	Andrews	Hillery			Appears on a Confederate listing of Roll of Honor selectees for the battle of Malvern Hill. No other records.

K,F	Stanley	James	T.	20	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862. Returned to duty. For Mar/Apr, 1863 muster roll, remarks say, "wounded" -- no details of date of wound or engagement. Hospital records show him admitted to the hospital in Richmond for a wound on 7/9/1863 (company records provide no details on date of wound or engagement). Hospital records show him admitted for a wound on 8/12/1863 at Richmond (again, company records provide no details -- may simply be a transfer to another hospital from the July wound). Returned to duty on 10/9/1863. Last muster (Jan/Feb, 1865) lists him as "absent without leave since 5 Feb, 1865." Federal records show him on a register of prisoners of war. Captured near luka, MS on 4/22/1865. Forwarded to Louisville, KY on 5/9/1865. Released on oath on 6/20/1865. A Federal hospital record shows his death from disease (dysentery) on 6/22/1865 at Louisville "Paroled Confederate charity patient."
L	Jordan	Charles	W.	32	Wounded at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862 Captured at Gettysburg on 7/1/1863. Sent to Fort Delaware where he died of disease on 3/31/1865 (or 3/30/1865). Grave location: "Jersey Shore."
L	Ward	James	M.	24	Killed in battle at Malvern Hill on 7/1/1862.
